Best Veteran went to Lyon's Branika Frills N Spills and Best Spec Beginner was Brown's Graythor Captain Hook.

Barbara Barganska did well in the Stakes classes coming 3rd in AVH BBE PD/B with Barbelka Dauntless Spirit (a.i.) and 1ST in AVH JD/B Junior Stakes . Barbara then took VHC in a huge AVH Brace class.
